III. Environmental Impact Assessments

In carrying out their respective activities, the Parties shall conduct environmental impact assessments in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Law and the relevant Regulations. The Parties shall not proceed with any activities that are likely to cause environmental pollution or ecological damage without obtaining the necessary approvals and permits from the relevant environmental protection authorities

IV. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from or in connection with this contract shall be resolved amicably through consultation between the Parties. If the Parties are unable to resolve the dispute through consultation, they shall submit the dispute to the competent court for resolution in accordance with the laws of the People`s Republic of China
