| <p>Section 2 - Visa Application Requirements</p> |

The Applicant shall submit a completed visa application form, along with the 2.1 required supporting documents, to the Consular Office.

2.2 The Applicant must provide proof of travel insurance covering the entire duration of their stay in Slovakia.

2.3 The Applicant shall pay the prescribed visa application fee as determined by the Consular Office.

2.4 The Applicant may be required to attend an interview with a consular officer .to discuss their visa application

Section 3 - Visa Issuance

The Consular Office reserves the right to refuse a visa application without 3.1 providing a reason for such refusal.

3.2 The issuance of a visa is subject to the discretion of the Consular Office and the fulfilment of all visa application requirements.

3.3 The validity period and conditions of the visa shall be determined by the .Consular Office at the time of issuance

Section 4 - Legal Compliance

The Applicant shall comply with all relevant laws and regulations of Slovakia 4.1 while present in the country.
